All Positions Will Require the candidate to submit a 400-600 typed, double-spaced, 12-point standard font, 1 in margins, essay covering the following four questions:

1. What is a leader?
2. How do you see the role of the leadership position you are applying for?
3. What qualities would you bring to the leadership position you are seeking?
4. What is your vision for the Lancer Band and Color Guard and how would you enact it.

Interviews will be held for Drum Major, Captains, Horn Sergeant and Managers. Interviews may be held for section leaders, crew and librarian.

For the Interview please be prepared to discuss:

- Your specific leadership experience
- Your experience in conflict resolution

Essays for Drum Major and Band Manager are due by Thursday, June 10 at 12 noon in LL-130 or Mr. Luck's mailbox in C-121.

All Candidates Must Submit the Following:

- **A Signed Application Form**
- **A 400-600 Leadership Essay**
- **A copy of your Unofficial College Transcripts from PCC and/or other colleges attending while in band. Incoming Freshman need to submit an unofficial copy of high school transcripts.**
